

# Pictish Symbol Stones - "Comb" Designs – Slide 1

There are 40 "comb" objects. 6 are indistinct.

22 designs emerged and are arranged into 4 groups.

"Combs" always appear with "mirrors".

These "combs" are of a separate design to "decorated rectangles".
