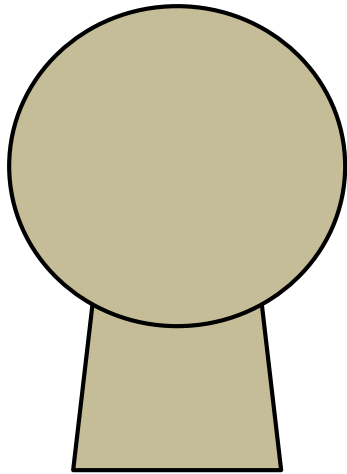
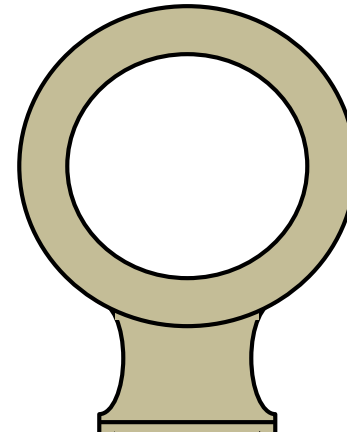


Pictish Symbol Stones – “Mirror Case” Designs - Slide 1



“Solid” pattern



“Hollow” pattern

There are 19 "mirror case" objects plus one "notched mirror case"(Sandside NC96NE 10).

1 is more like a "tuning fork"; the remainder are distinct.

Two broad patterns are - "hollow", i.e. an open circle on a base, and "solid".

17 “mirror case” designs emerged and 16 are arranged into 3 groups.

1 design (Newton of Lewesk) does not fit any group.

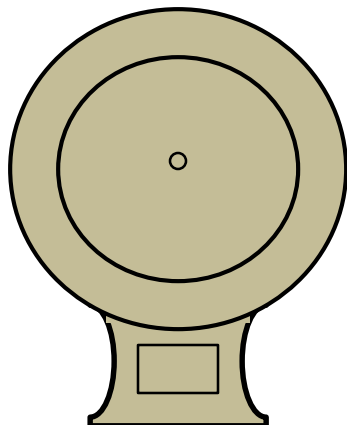

Non-concentric Design

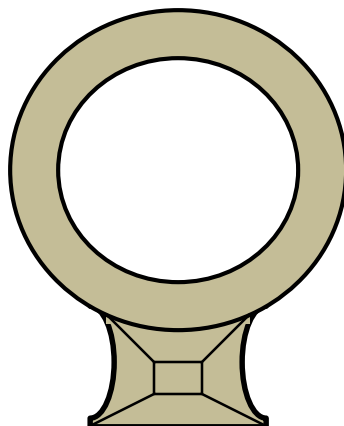
