

## **APPENDIX E**

### **Pictish Symbol Stones - Original Locations**

These pages categorise the original and currently very visible locations of the majority of the Stones that are not in museums and other public buildings. Some are listed against more than one category e.g. if in or from a Churchyard and by or near Water such as St Vigean and Brodie. This Appendix should be read in conjunction with “Original Locations of Symbol Stones”.

#### **CHURCH INTERIOR / FOUNDATIONS / WALL**

Ardnilly NJ42NE 2 – built into wall of church on site of Ardnilly House.  
Bourtie NJ82SW 4 – built into wall high up – 1806 church on site of former church.  
Fordoun NO77NW 3.2 – used as paving in old church / under base of pulpit of 1788 church.  
Inverallan NJ02NW 4 – found during removal of foundations of former church.  
Kinellar NJ81SW 6 – foundation stone of old church (1801).  
Kingoldrum NO35NW 3 – slab found in 1840 during demolition of earlier church.  
Kirriemuir NO35SE 20 – Stones discovered in foundations of former kirk during its demolition in 1787.  
Monifieth NO43SE 25 – four Stones found in foundation of former church incorporated into new church.  
Rhynie NJ42NE 30 – two slabs dug up from foundations of old church in 1878.  
Rosemarkie NH75NW 7 – found in floor of old church.  
St Vigean NO64SW 3 – several slabs and fragments from old church site.  
Tyrie NJ96SW 1 – slab recovered from foundation of the old parish church.

#### **CHURCHYARD / GRAVEYARD**

Brodie, “Rodney’s Stone” NH95NE 3 – from Dyke old church graveyard (NGR NH 9842 5766).  
Clatt NJ52NW 7 – found in kirkyard dyke (late 1800s / early 1900s).  
Clatt NJ52SW 12 – built into kirkyard wall.  
Dyce NJ81NE 8 – both Stones had been built into kirkyard dyke at St Fergus Church. St Fergus 8<sup>th</sup> century.  
Edzell 1 – NO56NE 7.03 – found in old kirkyard wall in 1870.  
Fetterangus NJ95SE 4 – found in kirkyard in 1876.  
Formaston, Aboyne NJ50SW 1 – found in churchyard shortly prior to 1887.  
Hilton of Cadboll NH87NE 7 – originally near the ruins of a chapel (Our Lady) within other earthworks.  
Inveravon NJ13NE 7.  
Inchbrayock NO75NW 2 – slab found in burial ground of St Braoch’s church in 1849.  
Inverurie NJ72SE 11 – four Stones discovered early 19 C in kirkyard.  
Kintore Churchyard NJ71NE 33 – dug up in churchyard.  
Navidale ND01NW23 – site of St Ninian’s Chapel.  
Nigg NH87SW 1 – stood in Nigg churchyard.  
Poolewe NG88SE 10 - Londubh burial-ground.  
St Madoes NO12SE 15.  
St Vigean NO64SW 3 – several slabs and fragments.  
Strathmartine Kirkyard NO33NE 7 – fragments of Stones.  
Tullich NO39NE 2 – by the doorway and surrounded by a railing at St Nathalan’s church (with 15 Cross Stones).

### **CHURCH OR CHAPEL NEARBY**

Advie NJ13SW 2 – found in burial ground of old church – built into current church wall.

Birnie NJ25NW 1 – by churchyard wall.

Birse NO59NE 18.02 – near church, site of medieval church, built into wall of manse.

Brough of Birsay HY22NW 1 – possibly on site of 6<sup>th</sup> C Celtic monastic settlement; was a Norse cathedral.

Congash NJ02NE 1 – site of chapel and graveyard (crop mark aerial outline).

Dingwall NH55NW 7 – been used as a lintel over a doorway of the church.

Dunfallandy NN95NW 29 – original location apparently in ruins of a chapel 1 mile SW of Killiecrankie or near the chapel at Dunfallandy.

Fin(d)larig NH92NE 3 – site of a chapel.

Migvie NJ40NW 2 – found at site of old church.

Pabbay, Barra NL68NW 2 – remains of dry stone walls of supposedly a chapel; Cross added to Stone (estimated to be circa 6<sup>th</sup> c) plus other Cross Stones.

Scoonie NO30SE 15 – found in churchyard.

Skinnet Chapel, Halkirk ND164SW 2 – was built into St Thomas Chapel (ruin).

South Ronaldsay ND49SE 1 – sill of a window in St Peter's church.

Strome Shunnamul, Benbecula NF85NW 5 – church about 2.5km away at Balivanich.

Struan NN 8087 6533 – now against current church wall; old church dedicated to St Fillan.

Tarbat NH98SW 15 – found in Tarbat churchyard.

### **MANSE**

Alyth NO24NW 14 – dug up in manse garden in 1887.

Turriff Manse NJ74NW 20 – built into garden wall of manse

### **STONE CIRCLE (part of or nearby)**

Aquhollie NO89SW 10 – carvings indistinct; Ogham.

Ardlair NJ52NE 3 – on brow of hill, another Stone 84 feet away on north – south line, perhaps remains of a stone circle.

Broomend of Crichtie NJ71NE 8 – was near a henge, now in centre.

Dores, Clune Farm NH63NW 13.

Nether Corskie NJ0NW 3 – two Stones believed to be part of a stone circle.

### **NEAR A BROCH**

Crosskirk ND07SW 4 – near broch / cairns at Crosskirk Bay, Reay.

Kintradwell NC90NW 15 – near Cinn Trolla broch with chapel and saint associations (St Tredwell).

### **ON A BARROW / TUMULUS**

Garbeg NH53SW 15 – by cairns near Drumnadrochit.

Keillor NO23NE 3 – stands on enclosed knoll or tumulus in which several urns have been found.

### **LONG CIST COVERS**

Dunrobin NC80SW 24 – likewise NC80SW 16

Drimmies NJ72SW 16.  
Tillytarmont NJ54NW 11.  
Wester Denoon NO34SE 16.

## **FRAGMENT FROM A DYKE**

Brandsbutt NJ72SE 23.

Advie NJ13SW 2 – River Spey.  
Ardnilly NJ42NE 2 – Burn of Ardnilly & River Spey.  
Arnhall NO66NW 113 – north bank of River Esk.  
Birnie NJ25NW 1 – River Lossie.  
Brodie, “Rodney’s Stone” NH95NE 3 – when at Dyke old church graveyard – Muckle Burn.  
Bruceston NO25SE 17 – River Isla.  
Cossans, St Orlands Stone NO54SW 4 – Dean Water (south) + Loch of Forfar (north east).  
Dunfallandy NN95NW 29 – River Tummel.  
Fordoun, Auchenblae NO77NW 3.2 – by the Luther Water (aka River Luther).  
Glenferness NH94SW 10 – by a bend in the River Findhorn.  
Inverallan NJ02NW 4 – River Spey.  
Inveravon NJ13NE 7 – River Spey.  
Invereen NH73SE 5 – by the River Findhorn near Moy / Tomatin.  
Inverurie NJ72SE 11 – by confluence of River Ury (Urie) and River Don.  
Kingoldrum NO35NW 3 – by Cromie Burn.  
Kintore, Castle Hill NJ71NE 32 – near River Don.  
Kintore, Churchyard NJ71NE 33 – near River Don.  
Knockando/Pulvrenan NJ24SW 4.01 – when Stones originally at Pulvrenan - River Spey.  
Logierait NN95SE 4 – Rivers Tay and Tummel.  
Meigle NO24SE 25 – River Erich.  
Monymusk NJ71NW 12 – River Don.  
Mortlach (Dufftown) NJ33NW 12 – Dullan Water runs behind graveyard.  
Nether Corskie NJ0NW 3 – on the slope to the north of Corskie Burn.  
Rhynie NJ42NE 35, 22, 36, 30, 52, 53 – Water of Bogie.  
St Madoes NO12SE 15 – Cairnie Pow (into Tay at Inchyra).  
St Vigeans NO64SW 3 – Brothock Water.  
Struan NN 8087 6533 – near Errochty Water.  
Tillytarmont NJ54NW 11 – confluence of Isla and Deveron.  
Tyrie NJ96SW 1 – Water of Tyrie.  
Upper Manbean NJ15NE 7 – near Tyrock Burn.

## **IN WATER**

Eassie NO34NE 4 – found in burn by old parish church late 18<sup>th</sup> C.  
Keith Hall NJ72SE 46 – found in River Don.

## **RAISED OR OPEN AREA**

Abdie NO21NE 10 – allegedly stood on crest of Kaim Hill.

Aberlemno Roadside NO55NW 8 (Crosstoun).

Ardlair NJ52NE 3 – on brow of hill, another Stone 84 feet away on north – south line.

Bruceton NO25SE 17 – a field on haughland of R Isla.

Cossans NO45SW 4 – isolated in low lying fields.

Fin(d)larig NH92NE 3 – on a low knoll.

Grantown NJ03SW 3 – at a large mound or knoll.

Kintore, Castle Hill NJ71NE 32 – raised ground.

Knowe of Burrian HY31NW 2 – natural hillock maybe site of a broch.

Picardy Stone NJ63SW 3 – Myreton Farm, Inch on open ground with a broad vista.

Rhynie NJ42NE 35 – “Craw Stane” overlooked by Tap ‘o Noth” hill. Surrounding crop marks have been researched.

Rhynie NJ42NE 52 – ploughed up on a farm at Barflat near bottom of hill from Craw Stane.

St Vigean NO64SW 3 – on a glacial mound.
